Privacy Notification for Participants at the Schizophrenia Masterclass 2021 (“Masterclass”)

1. Introduction

Otsuka Pharmaceutical Europe Limited (“Otsuka”) and H. Lundbeck A/S (“Lundbeck”) will be considered joint data controllers in relation to the personal data collected as part of your registration and participation in Schizophrenia Masterclass, as further described in this privacy notification. When your data is collected and handled by an Otsuka or Lundbeck affiliate, this affiliate will also be considered a data controller. In this notification, when we talk about personal data, we mean any information that relates to an identified or identifiable person – in this case, you.

Your personal data will be processed according to applicable legislation, including the EU General Data Protection Regulation (“**GDPR**”). You should read this notice, so you know what personal data we collect about you, what we do with it and how you can exercise your rights in connection with it. You should also read any other privacy notices that we give you, that might apply to our use of your personal data in specific circumstances from time to time.

2. What categories of personal data are we processing, for what purpose and on which legal basis?

The categories of personal data collected (outlined below) will vary depending on your relationship with Otsuka / Lundbeck. For example, the categories mentioned below represent those collected about healthcare professionals. If you are employee from Otsuka /Lundbeck, the categories of personal data will be broadly consistent with this but may vary slightly.

3. Will we disclose your personal data to third parties?

When your data is typed into the registration site, your personal data will be shared with the event manager, Virtual Hive, BCD Meeting and Events Limited in the UK as an independent data controller. Please find a link to the BCD privacy policy [here](#).

Your data will be shared on the basis of the GDPR Art. 6 (1) (f) and Otsuka and Lundbeck’s legitimate interest in transferring the data is to ensure that your participation in the Masterclass is handled and organized.

Your data may also be shared with IT Service Providers.

4. Will we transfer your personal data to recipients in countries outside the EU/EEA?

To the extent your data is transferred to IT service providers outside the EU, this will either be done on the basis of and [adequacy decision](#) of the The European Commission or on the basis of European Commissions approved “[Standard Contractual Clauses](#)” for the transfer to countries,

which have not been approved as providing an adequate level of protection. For more information, please reach out to the Lundbeck Data Protection Officer using the contact details below.

If your personal data are transferred to other Otsuka affiliates outside the EU/EEA, the transfer will ensure an adequate level of data protection is provided. If the data is transferred to other Lundbeck Group affiliates outside the EU/EEA, the transfer will be based on the Lundbeck Intra Group Agreement.

5. How long will we store your personal data?

We store your personal data for one calendar year after the Schizophrenia Masterclass has ended or as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes above.

6. Voluntary/mandatory provision of personal data

If you plan to participate in the Schizophrenia Masterclass, we will need to process your personal data. The consequences of not providing the personal data is that you are not able to participate.

7. Your rights

Otsuka and Lundbeck have taken necessary and adequate steps in order to protect your personal data and ensure your rights as a data subject. Please note that certain limitations may apply to your ability to exercise these rights. Subject to these limitations, you have the following rights:

- Right of access
- Right to rectification
- Right to erasure (right to be forgotten)
- Right to restriction
- Right to data portability

Right to object

- You have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning you which is based on legitimate interests as legal basis for the processing (as set out in article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) including profiling based on this provision.
- Where your personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes, you have the right to object at any time to processing of personal data concerning you for such marketing, which includes profiling to the extent that it is related to such direct marketing. Where you object to processing for direct marketing purposes, your data must no longer be processed for such purposes.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority, such as the UK Information Commissioner's Office or the Danish Data Protection Agency.

If you wish to exercise any of your rights as described above or have any questions, please contact Otsuka's European Data Privacy Officer or the Lundbeck Group Data Protection Officer who will handle any requests received on behalf of both parties by using the contact information provided below.

8. Joint controllers

For the purpose of this Masterclass, Otsuka and Lundbeck are considered joint controllers as set out in the GDPR art. 26. However, as Lundbeck is leading the project in 2021 on the registration site, and (iii) handling requests regarding your rights described in above.
